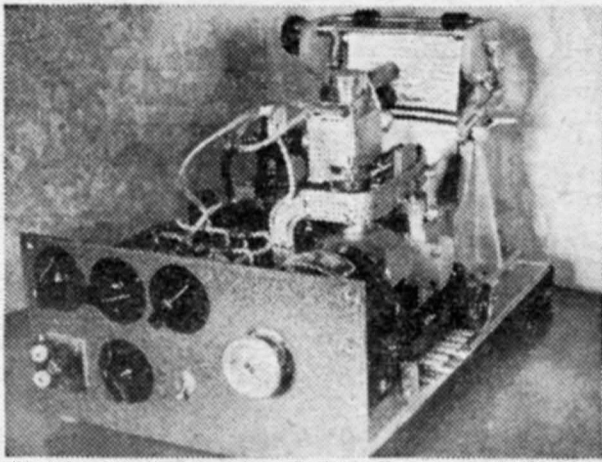
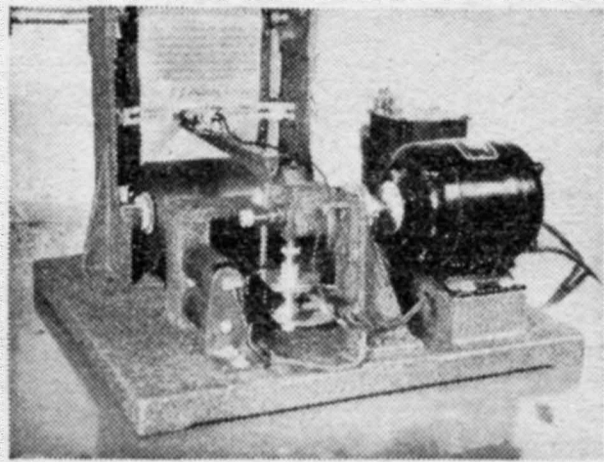

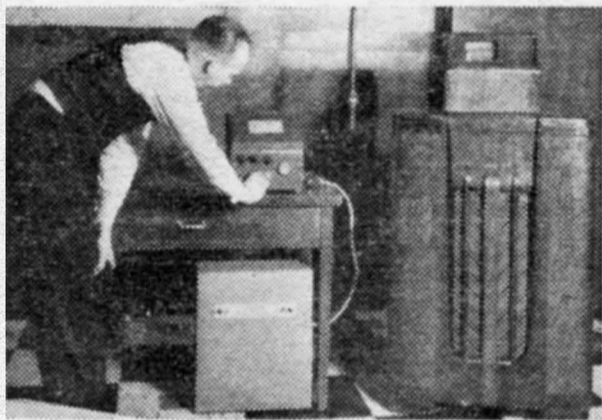

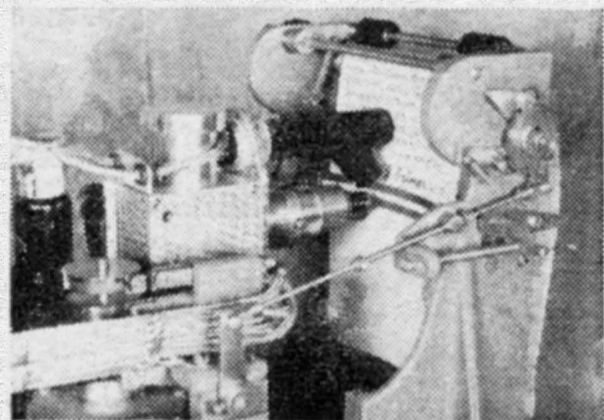
Above is one of the transmitters used by Radio Station WHO on its experimental facsimile broadcasts



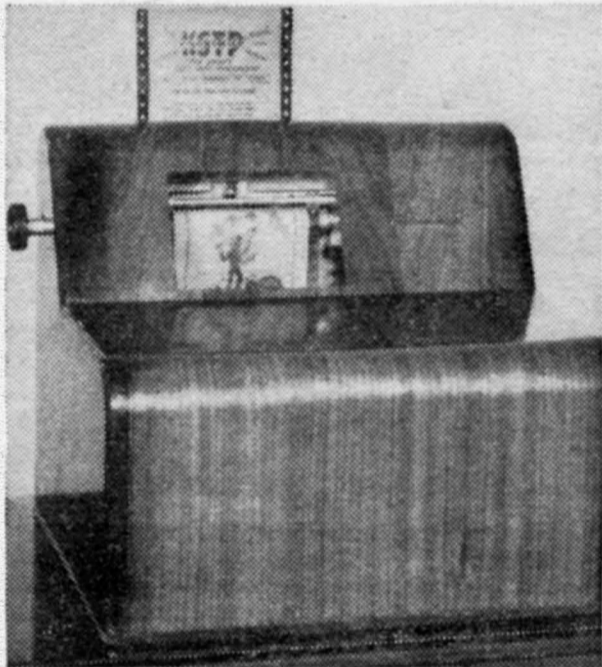
WHO experiments are conducted from 12 midnight until 1 o'clock. Above, a recorder with news-strip

TWO CONVICTS ESCAPE FROM ALCATRAZ

SAN FRANCISCO — Two desperate convicts, Theodore Cole and Ralph Rbe, accomplished the seemingly impossible tonight when they made good their escape from Alcatraz, grim, fortress-like prison island in San Francisco Bay. Under cover of heavy fog, the men broke from their cells earlier today, made their way to the water's edge, apparently leaped in and escaped in a waiting boat. It was the first flight from the prison, which heretofore had been thought escape-proof. At 2 a.m. today, coast guardsmen and prison officials had virtually given up the search for the two.

STATE G.O.P. VOTES REORGANIZATION
